In totaal, het die bees- en varkgetalle gestyg met 1,24% en 0,56% onderskeidelik, terwyl skaap- en bokgetalle verminder het met 0,13% en 0,52% onderskeidelik vanaf Augustus 2008 tot November 2008.

Beeste: Beesgetalle vir Suid-Afrika aan die einde van November 2008 word op 14,036 milj. beraam. Op provinsiale vlak word daar ongeveer 3,274 milj. (23%) beeste in die Oos-Kaap Provinsie aangetref, 2,789 milj. (20%) in KwaZulu-Natal Provinsie en 2,301 milj. (16%) in die Vrystaat Provinsie. Die oorblywende provinsies verteenwoordig gesamentlik sowat 41% (5,672 milj.) van die totale beesgetalle in Suid-Afrika.

Skape: Suid-Afrika se skaapgetalle aan die einde van November 2008 word op sowat 25,062 milj. beraam. Die meeste skape word in die Oos-Kaap Provinsie aangetref, naamlik 7,571 milj. (30%). Die Noord-Kaap Provinsie volg met 6,204 milj. (25%), en die Vrystaat Provinsie met 4,945 milj. (20%). Die oorblywende provinsies verteenwoordig sowat 25% (6,342 milj.) van die totale skaapgetalle in die RSA.

Varke: Varkgetalle vir Suid-Afrika aan die einde van November 2008 word op 1,623 milj. beraam. Die Limpopo Provinsie het die grootste getal varke, naamlik 379 761 (23%). Noordwes Provinsie volg met 330 165 (20%) en Wes-Kaap Provinsie met 183 677 (11%) varke. Die oorblywende provinsies verteenwoordig gesamentlik sowat 46% (730 005) van die totale getal varke.

Bokke: Suid-Afrika se bokgetalle vir einde November 2008 word op 6,495 milj. beraam. Die Oos-Kaap Provinsie geniet die grootste verteenwoordiging met ongeveer 2,428 milj. (37%), gevolg deur Limpopo met 1,311 milj. (20%) en KwaZulu-Natal met 855 380 (13%). Die oorblywende provinsies verteenwoordig gesamentlik sowat 30% of 1,901 milj van die totale getal bokke.

In total, the cattle and the pig numbers increased by approximately 1,24% and 0,56% respectively, while the sheep and the goat numbers decreased by approximately 0,13% and 0,52% respectively for the period August 2008 to November 2008.

Cattle: The number of cattle in the RSA at the end of November 2008 is estimated at 14,036 mill. Eastern Cape Province is leading at 3,274 mill or (23%), 2,789 mill (20%) in KwaZulu-Natal Province and 2,301 mill (16%) in the Free State Province. The remaining provinces represent 41% (5,672 mill) of the total cattle population in South Africa.

Sheep: The total number of sheep in the RSA at the end of November 2008 is estimated at 25,062 mill. The provincial distribution of sheep is as follows: 7,571 mill (30%) in the Eastern Cape Province, 6,204 mill (25%) in the Northern Cape Province, and 4,945 mill (20%) in the Free State Province. 6,342 mill. (25%) is shared among the remaining provinces.

Pigs: The number of pigs in the RSA at the end of November 2008 is estimated at 1,623 mill. Most of the South Africa's pig population is in the Limpopo Province at 379 761 (23%). The North West Province follows with 330 165 (20%) and the Western Cape Province with 183 677 (11%). The remaining provinces represent approximately 46% (730 005) of the total pig population.

Goats: Goat numbers in the RSA at the end of November 2008 are estimated at 6,495 mill, of which approximately 2,428 mill (37%) are found in the Eastern Cape Province, Limpopo Province follows with 1,311 mill (20%) and KwaZulu-Natal with 855 380 (13%). The rest, which is 30% or 1,901 mill, is shared among the remaining provinces.
