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1. Introduction

This publication updates Statistical Release P1101, *Census of commercial agriculture 2007*, and in many respects can be compared with Report 11-02-01, *Census of commercial agriculture 2002*. It provides statistics on employment, production, finance and general information with regard to active commercial farming enterprises in South Africa. The report also provides details of field crop and horticultural production, and animals and animal products produced by province. The financial information has been revised following the reclassification of some enterprises. A provincial breakdown of the financial figures published in the Statistical Release P1101, *Census of commercial agriculture 2007* is also provided in this report.

The report presents the results of 39 966 commercial farms that were active during the census of commercial agriculture, which was conducted from 1 March 2006 to 28 February 2007.

The statistical unit for the collection of information is a farming enterprise. An enterprise is a legal unit (or a combination of legal units) that includes and directly controls all functions necessary to carry out its production activities. The previous census of commercial agriculture was conducted in 2002 (Report No. 11-02-01, *Census of commercial agriculture 2002*).

1.1 Scope and coverage

The Census of commercial agriculture 2007 covers statistics of private and public enterprises, which are registered in the taxation system, and that are mainly engaged in:

- Growing of crops, market gardening and horticulture (SIC 111)
- Farming of animals (SIC 112)
- A combination of the above (mixed farming) (SIC 113)
- Game propagation, including related services (SIC 1151)
- Fish hatcheries and fish farms (SIC 132)

The following categories are excluded:

- Agricultural and animal husbandry services, except veterinary activities (SIC 114)
- Hunting, trapping and including related services (SIC 1152)
- Production of organic fertiliser (SIC 116)
- Forestry and related services (SIC 121)
- Logging and related services (SIC122)
- Ocean and coastal fishing (SIC 131)

Data in respect of agricultural smallholdings such as nurseries, vegetable gardens, flower farms and dairy farms are included in this report only in those cases where the products were intended for sale.

1.2 Data items

The following categories of data items were collected: details of employment, income, expenditure, debt, market value of assets and production statistics.

1.3 Reference period

The questionnaires were completed for the financial year of the enterprise which ended on any date between 1 March 2006 and 28 February 2007, according to the usual reporting schedule of the enterprise. The 2007 census period will be referenced as 2007 in the report.

1.4 Current prices

The rand values are at current prices.

1.5 Confidentiality

According to Section 17 of the Statistics Act, 1999 (Act No. 6 of 1999), completed questionnaires remain confidential to Statistics South Africa (Stats SA). Individual business information is never disclosed. Results are presented in aggregated form only.

In comparing the results of the 2002 and 2007 censuses the following should be borne in mind:


- There was a better coverage of the poultry sector in 2007 as compared with 2002.
- Drought conditions which prevailed in various parts of the country during the census period influenced the field crop production.

2. Key findings

2.1 Ownership


Figure A shows farm distribution by type of ownership. It can be deduced from both Figure A and Table 1.3 that 83,2% of the 39 966 active farming units in the commercial sector were owned and operated by individuals, followed by close corporations (5,7%) and private companies (5,4%). The smallest proportion of owners and operators were those classified as 'other' (co-operations, government departments and public corporations) with a contribution of 0,6% to the total number of farming units.

It can be observed from Figure B and Table 1.3 that about 52,4% of gross farming income was generated from farming units owned by individuals, followed by private companies with 33,6%. The smallest contribution towards the gross farming income was made by units that are owned by 'other' and families with 1,2% and 1,5% respectively.


Figure B – Distribution of gross farming income according to type of ownership



2.2 Capital expenditure

Figure C shows the distribution of capital expenditure by major categories. Land, buildings and development work undertaken constituted the largest expenditure item (57,3%) recorded from a total capital expenditure of R2 859 million in the commercial agricultural sector. This was followed by the purchase of new assets (29,4%) and capital expenditure on existing assets (13,3%) (see Tables 4.3.1).

Figure C – Distribution of capital expenditure




2.3 Farming debt

Figure D shows the distribution of the R39 580 million farming debt owed by farming units to different lenders. The largest lenders to the commercial agricultural sector were commercial banks and private persons, to which the sector owed R17 144 million and R10 306 million respectively.

The public lender in the agricultural sector, Land Bank, lent R2 585 million to commercial farmers (see Table 7.2).

Figure D – Farming debt distribution by type of lender




2.4 Market value of assets

The market value of assets amounted to R179 525 million and it can be shown from Figure E and Table 6 that farming land contributes the most towards the farming assets with 56,4% (R101 231 million), followed by fixed improvements with 18,5% (R33 300 million). The highest market value in assets was recorded in Western Cape and Free State with R44 054 million and R25 062 million respectively.

Figure E shows the distribution of the market value of assets by province and asset item. It can also be seen from Figure E that in all the provinces the contribution of farming land makes up at least 50% to the market value of the farming assets.


Figure E – Distribution of market value of assets by province



2.5 Losses

The commercial agricultural sector experienced total losses of R2 382 million. As demonstrated in Figure F, the highest losses in the commercial agricultural sector were experienced in Free State (R384 million) and in Mpumalanga (R367 million). The lowest loss was reported in Gauteng at R100 million (see Table 5).

2.6 Gross farming income

Field crops

Table A shows that the income earned from major field crops during 2007, with the exception of wheat, increased compared with 2002. The income generated from maize for grain amounted to R8 252 million in 2007 compared with R7 805 million in 2002. This reflects a 1,1% increase annually between 2002 and 2007.

Horticulture

Income earned from major horticultural crops also reflected increases between 2002 and 2007 (see Table A). In comparative terms, there was a 10,1% annualized increase in income generated from potatoes from R1 598 million in 2002 to R2 591 million in 2007. Income earned from oranges and grapes also showed increases of 3,3% and 4,1% annually between 2002 and 2007 respectively.

Animals and animal products

As illustrated in Table B, the income earned from sales of animals and animal products also registered an increase between the two census years 2002 and 2007.



2.7 Employment

Figure G shows that, with the exception of Western Cape and Northern Cape, the number of full-time workers was proportionally higher than casual and seasonal workers in all provinces. The highest proportion of full-time workers was recorded in Gauteng (73,3%), followed by KwaZulu-Natal (66,1%) and Limpopo (59,3%).

Explanatory notes

- Universe**
- 1 The universe of the 2007 Census of Commercial Agriculture differed considerably from the agriculture censuses in the past. This census covered the whole country, based on a business register containing all businesses registered for VAT with the South African Revenue Service (SARS).
All enterprises are legally bound to register for VAT when their turnover for a period of twelve months equals or exceeds R300 000. However, those with a turnover of less than R300 000 may register for VAT voluntarily. From the commercial farming units registered for VAT, a total of 39 966 were identified as live and active at the time of the census, and formed the universe for the census.
- Scope**
- 2 Information was obtained from commercial farmers who worked on their own farms or rented farms or farmed land on shares.
For the purpose of the census, farming means:
 - the growing of field crops, fruit, grapes, nuts, seeds, trees in a nursery, bulbs, vegetables and flowers in the open air or under cover;
 - operations at nurseries excluding those predominantly engaged in reselling;
 - the operation of tea, coffee and sugar plantations;
 - the raising of livestock, game, poultry, rabbits, freshwater fish, furbearing and other animals; and
 - the production of milk, wool, pelt/fur, eggs and honey for commercial purposes.
- Forestry (e.g. timber, wattle, wood and other plantations), ocean fishing and agricultural services were not included in the census. Data in respect of agricultural smallholdings such as nurseries, vegetable gardens, flower farms and dairy farms are included in this report only in those cases where products were intended for sale.
- Response rate**
- 3 As indicated in Table F below, of the 39 966 farming units that formed the universe, 2 927 had an income of more than R5 million each per annum, whereas 22 577 had an income of less than R500 000 each per annum.
Farming units in the largest income group had the highest usable response rate (78,9%). The groups with the lowest response rates were income groups 3 and 4, with response rates of 61,7% and 53,3% respectively.

These expenses include seed stock, poultry feeds, fertilisers, fuel, packing material, electricity purchased, interest paid and all other operating expenses. Railage and rented transport are also included with the relevant purchases. |
| Farmer | 3 A farmer is the individual, partnership, close corporation, company, or other enterprise that operates a farming unit for their own account; or the manager, foreman or other person to whom the control of the farming unit was entrusted. |
| Farming debt | 4 Includes all financial obligations incurred in respect of normal farming activities, such as mortgages, loans and credits received from organisations such as banks, cooperative societies and private persons. Debt in respect of other business enterprises is not included. Particulars regarding farming debt are based on the data submitted by respondents. |
| Farming unit | 5 A farming unit means any unit on which one or more of the following farming operations are carried out for commercial purposes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The cultivation in the open air or under cover of field crops, fruit, grapes, nuts, seed bulbs, vegetable plants or flowers; • The operation of tea, coffee and sugar plantations; • The breeding of livestock, poultry, game or other animals, including freshwater fish, furred animals and trade in livestock; and/or • The production of milk, wool, fur, eggs or honey. |
| Gross farming income | 6 Includes income earned from agricultural products sold, but excludes other income generated outside farming. ' <i>Casual and seasonal employees</i> ' include occasional and day labourers, e.g. shearers, reapers and fruit-pickers, but exclude contractors and their employees. |
