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SECTION A

ECONOMIC INDICATORS AND TRENDS

1. CROP ESTIMATES AND FORECASTS

Areas planted and fourth production forecast for summer crops for the 2024 production season

According to the fourth production forecast for summer crops by the Crop Estimates Committee (CEC) for the 2024 production season, the expected commercial **maize** crop was 13,310 million tons, which is 19,0% or 3,120 million tons less than the 16,430 million tons of the 2023 season. The estimated area planted to maize by South African commercial maize producers during the 2024 season is 2,636 million ha—1,9% or 50 150 ha more than the 2,586 million ha planted the previous season. The expected yield is 5,05 t/ha. The ratio of white to yellow maize plantings was estimated at 59:41. The estimated white maize plantings were 1,555 million ha, which is an increase of 2,2% from the previous season's plantings of 1,521 million ha. Yellow maize plantings were estimated to be 1,081 million ha—1,6% more than the 1,065 million ha for 2023.

During the 2024 production season, most of the country's maize crop was planted in Free State (47,4%), North West (20,1%) and Mpumalanga (19,7%). The plantings of maize increased by 5,8%, from 1,181 million ha to 1,250 million ha in Free State and by 2,3% in Mpumalanga, from 508 500 ha to 520 000 ha. Plantings in North West are estimated at 530 000 ha—a decrease of 4,7% from the 556 000 ha planted for the 2023 season.

The production forecast for white maize was 6,343 million tons, which is 25,4% less than the 8,505 million tons of the previous season. The expected yield for white maize was 4,08 t/ha, as against 5,59 t/ha in 2023. In the case of yellow maize, the production forecast was 6,967 million tons, which is 12,1% less than the 7,925 million tons the previous season. The yield for yellow maize was expected to be 6,44 t/ha, as against 7,44 t/ha for 2023.

A **sunflower seed** crop of 649 250 tons was expected, which is 9,8% less than the 720 000 tons of the previous season. The area planted to sunflower seed was estimated at 529 000 ha, which is 4,8% lower than the 555 700 ha planted for 2023. The expected yield for 2024 was 1,23 t/ha, as against 1,30 t/ha in 2023.

The production forecast for **soya beans** was 1 779 million tons, which is 35,8% less than the 2,770 million tons of the previous season. The estimated area planted to soya beans was 1,150 million ha, which is 0,2% or 2 200 ha more than the 1,148 million ha planted for 2023. The expected yield was 1,55 t/ha, as against 2,41 t/ha in 2023.

The expected **groundnut** crop was 54 440 tons, which is 2,7% more than the 53 000 tons of the 2023 season. The area planted to groundnuts was estimated at 41 200 ha, which is 31,6% or 9 900 ha more than the 31 300 ha planted the previous season. The expected yield was 1,32 t/ha, as against 1,69 t/ha in 2023.

The production forecast for **sorghum** was 95 830 tons—1,6% more than the 94 360 tons of the previous season. The area planted to sorghum was estimated to be 42 100 ha, which is 23,8% or 8 100 ha more than the 34 000 ha planted for 2023. The expected yield was 2,28 t/ha, as against 2,78 t/ha the previous season.

The production of **dry beans** was expected to be 52 190 tons—3,8% more than the 50 260 tons of the previous season. The estimated area planted was 39 550 ha, or 7,9% more than the 36 650 ha planted the previous season, with an expected yield of 1,32 t/ha for 2024, as against a yield of 1,37 t/ha in 2023.

Intended plantings of winter crops for the 2024 production season

Producers' intentions to plant winter cereals are based on the results of a non-probability survey conducted by the Directorate: Statistics and Economic Analysis of the Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development and reflects the position as at the middle of April 2024.

The figures for wheat represent the total number of hectares that are intended to be planted for grain, excluding any hectares that will be planted for fodder and grazing.

Early indications are that producers intend to plant 520 200 ha of **wheat** for the 2024 season. This is 3,3% or 17 750 ha less than the 537 950 ha planted to wheat in 2023. The main producing areas are within Western Cape with 370 000 ha (71%), followed by Free State with 55 000 ha (11%) and Northern Cape with 40 000 ha (8%).

The expected area planted to **barley** is 102 000 ha, which is 5,2% or 5 600 ha less than the 107 600 ha of the previous year. The expected area planted to **canola** is 141 100 ha, which is 7,5% or 9 900 ha more than the 131 200 ha planted in 2023. Producers intend to plant 20 500 ha of **oats**, which is 25,5% or 7 000 ha less than the 27 500 ha of the previous season. The expected area planted to **sweet lupines** is 15 000 ha, which is 6,3% or 1 000 ha less than the previous season.

3. ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

This article gives an overview of the major macroeconomic changes in the agricultural sector from the period 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023 to the period 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024.

Gross farming income

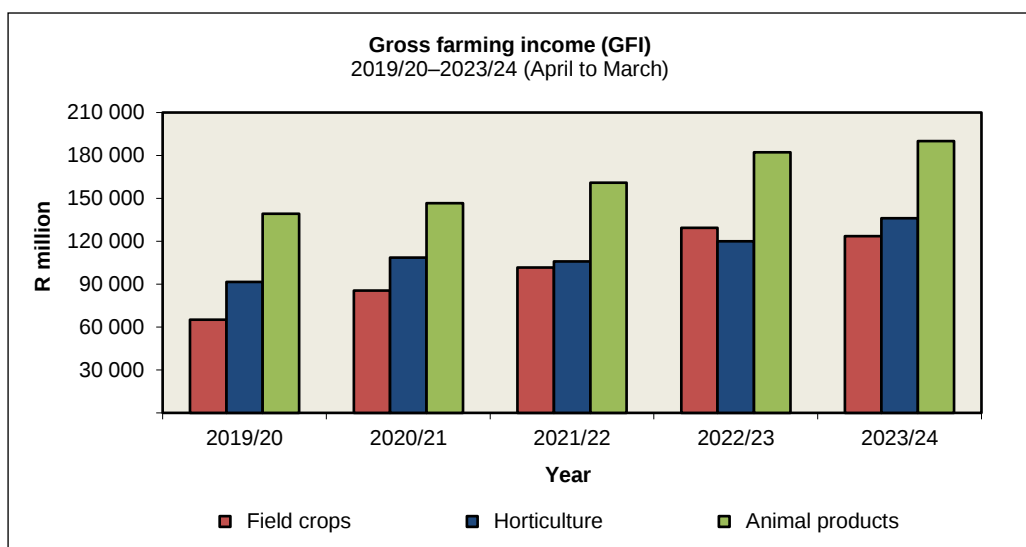
Gross farming income refers to the agricultural production that is marketed, together with the part that is for own consumption, both valued at basic prices.

Gross farming income from all agricultural products increased by 4,3% to R449 853 million for the period ended March 2024, from R431 470 million the previous corresponding period. This was mainly driven by the increase in income from horticultural and animal products.

The income earned from field crops decreased by 4,5% and amounted to R123 677 million, which was owing to the decreases in income from grain sorghum by 33,5%, sunflower seed (26,1%), wheat (13,6%), maize (12,9%) and canola (10,3%).

The income from horticultural products increased by 13,6% to R136 152 million, compared to R119 903 million. The main contributors were the income earned from citrus fruit by 22,5%, vegetables by 20,1%, subtropical fruit by 6,9% and deciduous and other fruit by 3,8%.

The income from animal products increased by 4,3% from R182 105 million to R190 024 million, largely because of the increase in income from eggs by 16,4%, milk by 15,0% and poultry meat by 8,4%.



Expenditure on intermediate production inputs

Expenditure on intermediate production inputs refers to the value of the goods and services that were purchased to be consumed as inputs during the production process.

Expenditure on intermediate goods and services increased by 3,8% to R252 148 million for the period ended 31 March 2024, as compared to R242 927 million in the previous corresponding period. This can be attributed to the increase in the expenditure on seed and plants and building and fencing material by 10,0% each, animal health and crop protection (8,8%), maintenance and repairs of machinery and implements (8,0%), packing material (7,9%), farm services (6,0%), fuel (5,6%) and farm feeds (0,9%). The expenditure on fertilisers showed a decrease of 2,6%.

Farm feeds accounted for the largest share of 35,9% total expenditure on goods and services, followed by fertilisers (12,1%), farm services (9,9%), fuel (8,4%), maintenance and repairs of machinery and

implements (6,8%), building and fencing material (4,1%) and animal health and crop protection and packing material (4,0%) each.

Prices received and prices paid by farmers, as well as terms of trade

Prices earned by the farmers for their agricultural products increased on average by 5,7% during the period under review. This was largely owing to the increase in prices of horticultural and animal products by 18,2% and 6,3%, respectively.

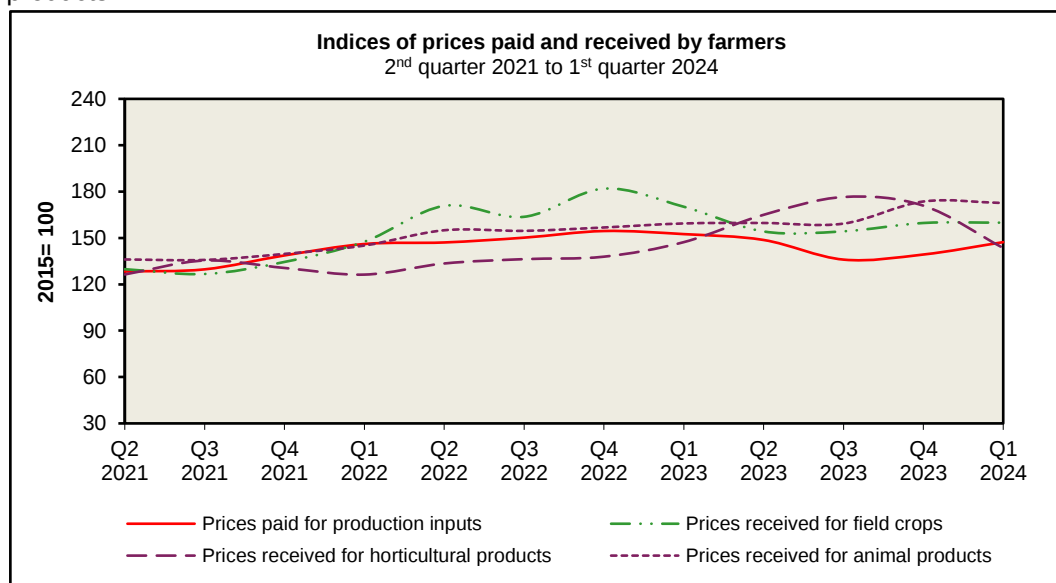
The weighted average price of field crops showed a decrease of 8,0%, which was mainly influenced by the decrease in the prices of summer grains by 15,9%, oilseeds by 11,5% and winter grains by 8,4%.

The increase of 18,2% in the average price of horticultural products was owing to the increase in prices of vegetables by 23,8%, fruit by 15,3% and viticulture by 9,7%.

The weighted average price of animal products increased by 6,3% owing to the increase in the prices of poultry meat by 19,2% and milk by 13,7%. The prices of slaughtered stock and pastoral products decreased by 8,2% and 6,2%, respectively.

The prices paid for farming requisites, including machinery and implements, material for fixed improvements and intermediate goods and services, decreased by 5,5% for the period ended March 2024, compared to an increase of 11,3% the previous period. The main contributors to the decrease in prices paid for production inputs were the decrease in the prices of animal health and crop protection by 14,0%, fertilisers (13,55) and fuel (1,3%).

Domestic terms of trade increased by 12,7% from 1,02 to 1,15, owing to improved prices paid for the agricultural products.



Net farm income and cash flow

The gross farming income increased by 4,3% and the expenditure on intermediate goods production inputs by 3,8%, which led to the net farming income increasing by 5,7%. The interest payment increased by 11,1%, while labour remuneration and rent payment increased by 5,6% each.

The farmers' cash flow increased by 3,7% to R117 042 million, from R112 904 million the previous period.

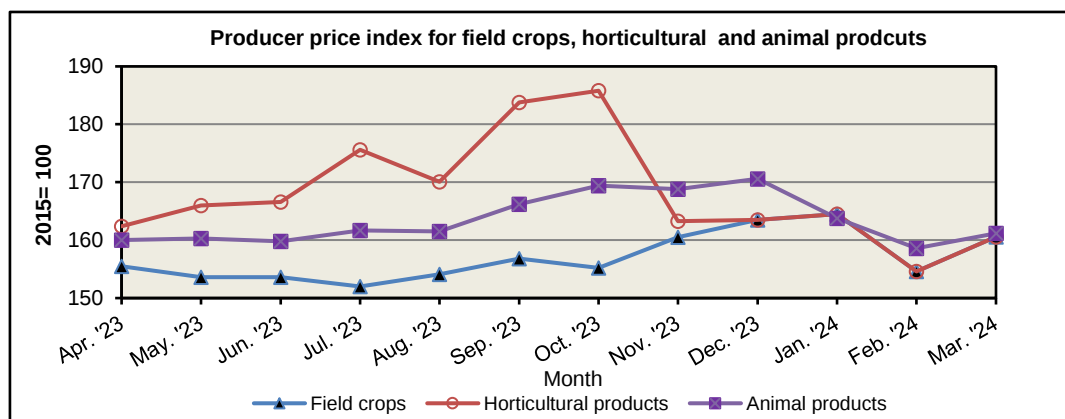
Conclusion

The increase in gross income was largely driven by the increase in production levels of field crops by 5,1% as well as prices of horticultural and animal products. On the other hand, the output levels of horticultural and animal products including the prices of field crops showed a decrease.

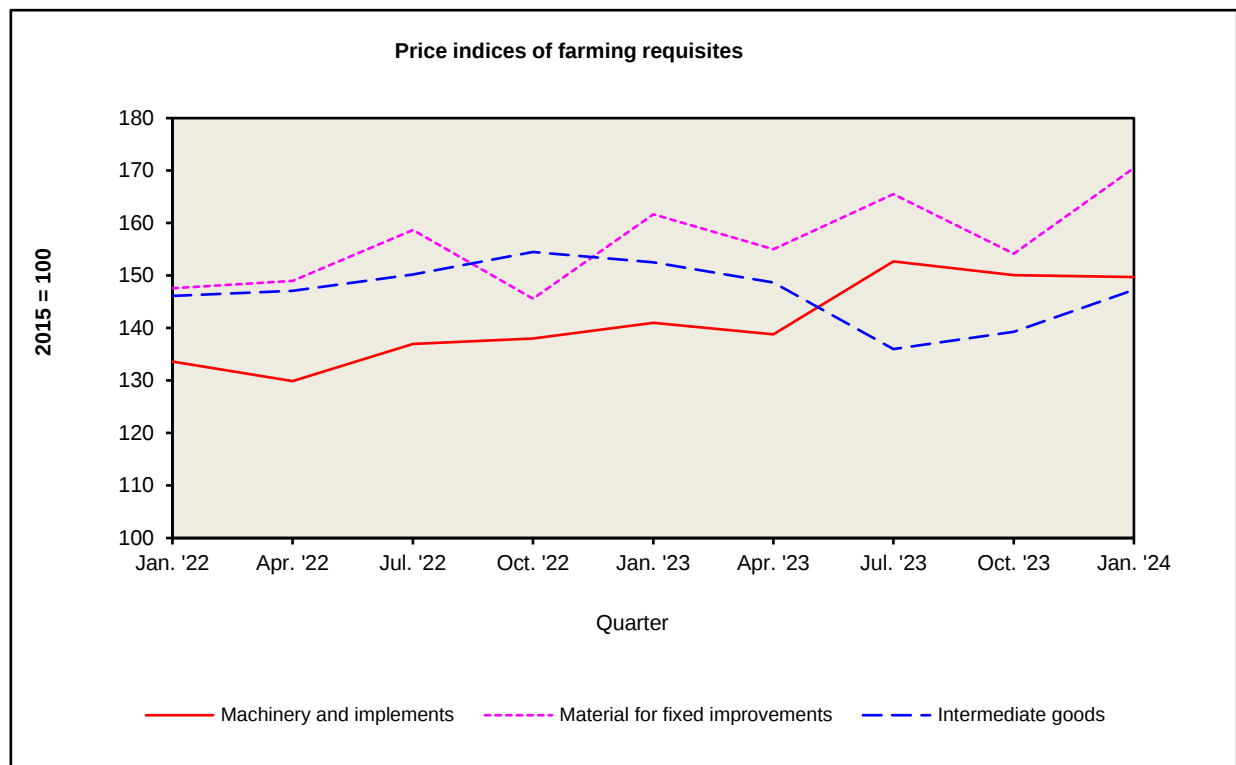

SECTION B

FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS OVERVIEW

FRESH MARKET STATISTICS OF SEASONAL FLUCTUATIONS IN QUANTITIES AND PRICES OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES SOLD ON THE MAJOR FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS

The purpose of this overview is to show the short-term price and volume trends (seasonal fluctuations) of various types of fruit and vegetables sold on major fresh produce markets and to make comparisons between the markets.

Market prices are determined by the interaction between supply and demand, which is influenced by various factors. Supply factors include climate, seasonal production, perishability of products and producers' reaction to prices realised in preceding periods, etc. Demand factors include consumer preferences, substitution between products and per capita income. Therefore, the seasonal pattern of quantities sold, and prices realised, may differ considerably among the various markets.
