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SECTION A

ECONOMIC INDICATORS AND TRENDS

1. CROP ESTIMATES AND FORECASTS

Areas planted and final production estimate for summer crops for the 2024 production season

According to the final production estimate for summer crops by the Crop Estimates Committee (CEC) for the 2024 production season, the expected South African maize crop was 12,724 million tons, which was 22,6% less than the 16,430 million tons of the 2023 season and 14,9% or 2,234 million tons less than the five-year average of 14,958 million tons up to 2023.

The estimated area that South African commercial producers planted to maize during the 2024 season was 2,636 million ha. This was 1,9% or 50 150 ha more than the 2,586 million ha planted in the previous season. Of this area, 1,250 million ha (47,4%) were in Free State, 530 000 ha (20,1%) in North West and 520 000 ha (19,7%) in Mpumalanga.

The plantings of maize in Free State increased by an estimated 5,8%, from 1,181 million ha in 2023 to 1,250 million ha in 2024 and in North West, it decreased by 4,7%, from 556 000 ha to 530 000 ha. Plantings in Mpumalanga increased by an estimated 2,3%, from 508 500 ha in 2023 to 520 000 ha in 2024.

The ratio of white to yellow maize plantings for 2024 is 59:41, same as the previous season. The estimated white maize plantings were 1,555 million ha, which were 2,2% more than the previous season's 1,521 million ha, while the yellow maize plantings were estimated to be 1,081 million ha—1,6% more than the 1,065 million ha for 2023.

Most of the country's maize crop was produced in Free State (41,7%), Mpumalanga (27,0%) and North West (10,1%).

The production estimate for white maize was 6,007 million tons, which was 29,4% or 2,498 million tons less than the 8,505 million tons of 2023 and 1,802 million tons less than the average of the five years up to 2023. The expected yield for white maize was 3,86 t/ha, as against 5,59 t/ha the previous season.

In the case of yellow maize, the production estimate was 6,717 million tons, which was 15,2% or 1,208 million tons lower than the 7,925 million tons of the previous season and 431 550 tons less than the five-year average up to 2023. The yield for yellow maize was expected to be 6,21 t/ha, as against 7,44 t/ha in 2023.

The expected sunflower seed crop was 635 750 tons, which was 11,7% less than the 720 000 tons of the previous season and 14,3% less than the average of 742 010 tons for the five years up to 2023. The area planted to sunflower seed was estimated at 529 000 ha, which was 4,8% less than the 555 700 ha planted in 2023. The expected yield was 1,20 t/ha, as against 1,30 t/ha the previous season.

The production estimate for soya beans was 1,840 million tons, which was 33,6% less than the 2,770 million tons of the previous season. The estimated area planted was 1,150 million ha, which was 0,2% or 2 200 ha more than the 1,148 million ha planted in 2023. The expected yield was 1,60 t/ha, as against 2,41 t/ha in 2023.

The expected groundnut crop was 51 745 tons, which was 2,4% or 1 255 tons less than the 53 000 tons of the 2023 season and 4 689 tons more than the five-year average of 47 056 tons per annum up to 2023. The area planted to groundnuts was an estimated 41 200 ha, which was 31,6% or 9 900 ha more than the 31 300 ha planted the previous season. The expected yield was 1,26 t/ha, as against 1,69 t/ha in 2023.

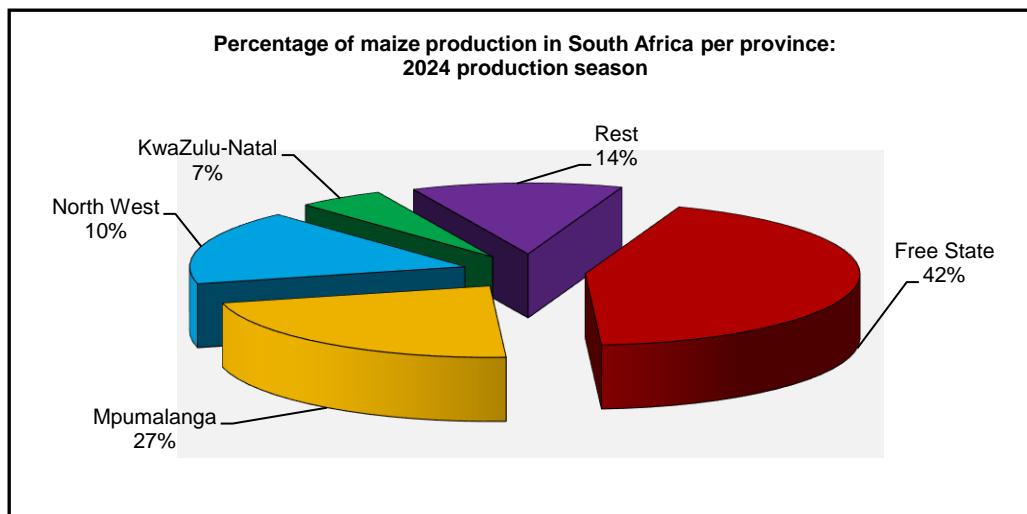
The production estimate for sorghum was 97 810 tons—3,7% more than the 94 360 tons of the previous season. The area planted to sorghum was estimated to be 42 100 ha, which was 23,8% or 8 100 ha more than the 34 000 ha planted in 2023. The expected yield was 2,32 t/ha, as against 2,78 t/ha the previous season.

The production of dry beans was expected to be 50 495 tons, which was 0,5% or 235 tons more than the 50 260 tons of the previous season and 7 840 tons less than the five-year average of 58 335 tons per annum up to 2023. The estimated area planted was 39 550 ha, which was 7,9% more than the 36 650 ha planted the previous season. The expected yield was 1,28 t/ha, as against 1,37 t/ha for 2023.

Intended plantings of summer grain crops for the 2025 production season

Figures on the intended plantings of summer crops for the 2025 production season were released by the Crop Estimates Committee (CEC) on 29 October 2024. Based on inputs received from a sample of producers, the area expected to be planted to maize on commercial farms was 2,640 million ha, of which 1,578 million ha (60%) were earmarked for white maize and 1,062 million ha (40%) for yellow maize. The commercial producers intended to increase the area planted to white maize by 22 850 ha (1,5%) and decrease yellow maize plantings by 19 000 ha (1,8%) from the previous season.

In the case of sunflower seed, intended plantings were estimated at 540 000 ha, which is 2,1% or 11 000 ha more than the 529 000 ha planted the previous season.

The intended plantings of soya beans showed an increase of 0,2% from the area planted the previous season, from 1,150 million ha to 1,153 million ha.

The intended plantings of groundnuts were 2,9% lower than the area planted the previous season, from 41 200 ha to 40 000 ha.

The plantings of sorghum were expected to increase by 28,3%, from 42,100 ha to 54 000 ha.

The intended plantings of dry beans also showed an increase of 14,0%, from the area planted the previous season, from 39 550 ha to 45 105 ha.

Approximately 87% of the total area planted to summer grain crops in South Africa during the past three years was located in Free State (47%), North West (21%) and Mpumalanga (19%).

Fourth production forecast for winter crops for the 2024 production season

According to the fourth production forecast for 2024 released by the CEC on 27 November 2024, the expected wheat crop was 1,940 million tons, which is 5,4% or 110 360 tons less than the crop of 2,050 million tons of the previous season. The expected yield was 3,84 t/ha, as against 3,81 t/ha the previous season.

The main wheat producing areas for 2024 are within Western Cape with 368 000 ha (72,8%), followed by the Free State with 49 000 ha (9,7%). The expected yield for Western Cape was 3,00 t/ha, as against 2,97 t/ha the previous season and 4,55 t/ha for Free State, compared to 3,90 t/ha.

The production forecast for barley was 371 535 tons. The area planted was estimated at 100 700 ha, while the expected yield was 3,69 t/ha.

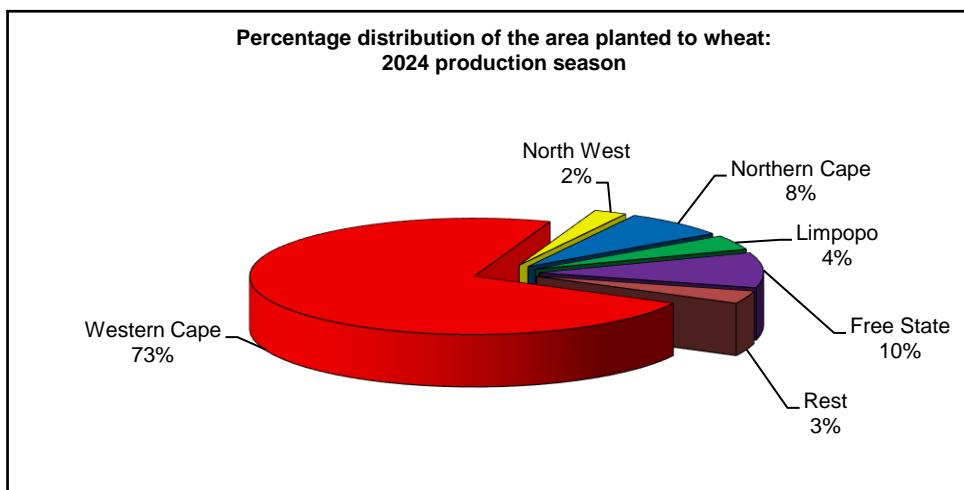
The expected canola crop was 295 445 tons, while the area estimate was 165 750 ha, with an expected yield of 1,78 t/ha. This is the largest canola crop produced in the history of South Africa.

The expected oats crop was 56 300 tons. The area planted was estimated at 31 000 ha, while the expected yield was 1,82 t/ha.

The expected sweet lupines crop was 19 200 tons, while the area estimate was 16 000 ha. The expected yield was 1,20 t/ha.

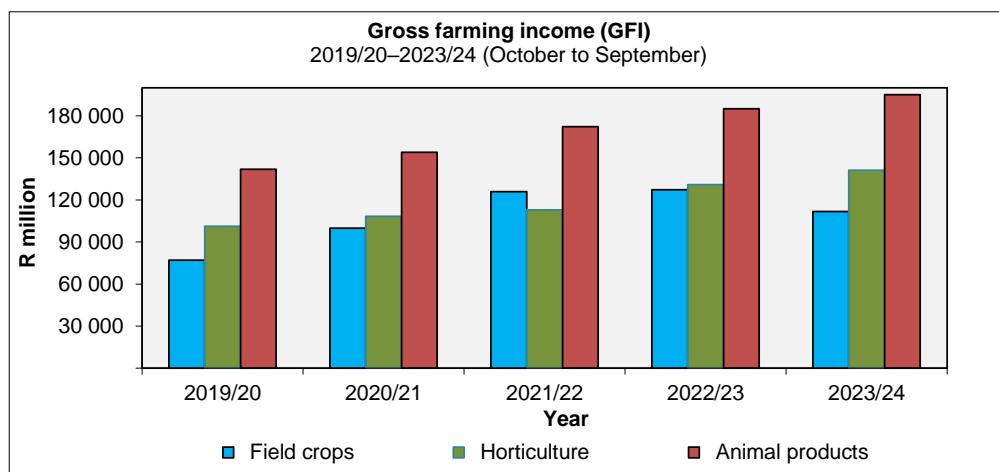
3. ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

This article gives an overview of the major macroeconomic trends in the agricultural sector for the period 1 October 2023 to 30 September 2024. Aggregates are compared with the period 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023.

Gross farming income

Gross farming income refers to that part of agricultural production that is marketed, together with the part that is for own consumption, both valued at basic prices.

Gross farming income earned from all agricultural products increased by 1,1% and is estimated to be R448 086 million for the period ended September 2024, compared to R443 220 million the previous corresponding period. This was largely driven by the increase in income from horticultural products by 7,8% and animal products by 5,4%.



Income earned from field crops decreased by 12,1% to R111 842 million, due to the decrease in income from soya beans by 37,6%, wheat by 16,9%, cotton by 13,1%, canola by 10,4%, maize and sunflower seed by 9,0% each and groundnuts by 4,4%. Income from dry beans increased by 25,1%, sugar cane by 14,5% and grain sorghum by 2,0%,

Income from horticultural products increased by 7,8% to R141 108 million, due to the increase in income from subtropical fruit by 15,5%, deciduous and other fruit (11,2%), vegetables (6,8%) and citrus fruit (1,0%).

Income from animal products increased by 5,4% to R196 136 million, due to the increase in income from eggs by 27,5%, milk by 8,3% and pigs slaughtered by 7,4%. Income from sheep slaughtered decreased by 11,0% and cattle and calves slaughtered by 3,6%.

Expenditure on intermediate production inputs

Expenditure on intermediate production inputs refers to the value of goods and services that were purchased to be consumed as inputs during the production process.

Expenditure on intermediate goods and services decreased slightly by 0,03% to R250 780 million, compared to R250 846 million the previous period. This was mainly driven by the decrease in expenditure on farm feeds by 9,2% and fertilisers by 2,6%.

Farm feeds remained the largest expenditure item, accounting for 33,9% of the total expenditure on intermediate goods and services, followed by fertilisers (12,0%), farm services (10,3%), fuel (8,6%), maintenance and repairs of machinery and implements and seed and plants (7,1%) each, building and fencing material (4,4%), animal health and crop protection (4,2%) and packing material (4,1%).

Prices received and paid by farmers

Prices received by farmers for their production increased on average by 6,1% for the period ended 30 September 2024.

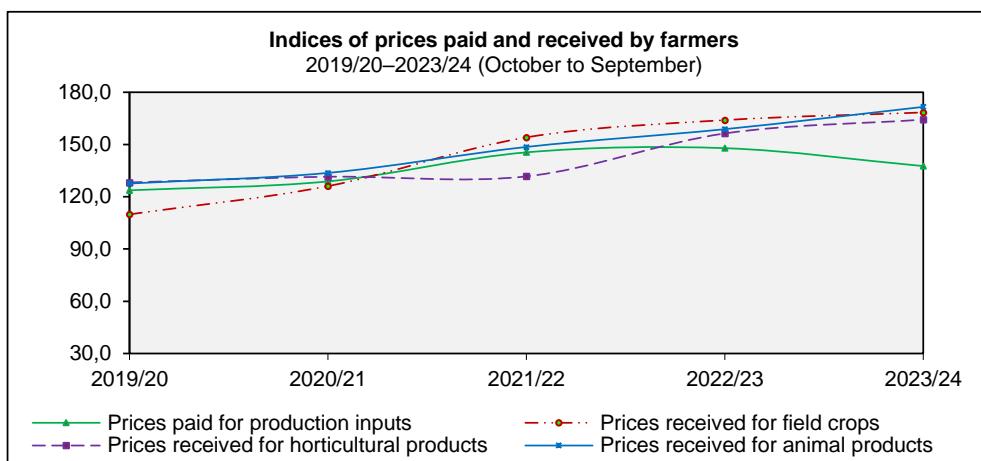
The weighted average price of field crops increased by 2,7%, due to the increase in prices of sugar cane by 17,7%, summer grains (4,6%), oilseeds (1,3%) and cotton slightly (0,3%). The prices of winter grains decrease by 14,2%.

The weighted average price of horticultural products increased by 5,8% due to the increase in prices of viticulture by 9,4%, fruit by 7,8% and vegetables slightly by 0,6%.

The weighted average price of animal products increased by 8,1% due to the decrease in the prices of poultry meat and milk by 18,1% and 4,7%, respectively. The prices of pastoral products decreased by 2,7% and slaughtered stock by 1,2%.

The prices paid for farming requisites, including machinery and implements, intermediate goods and services and material for fixed improvements decreased by 7,0%, compared to an increase of 1,7% in the previous period. This was the result of the decrease in prices of animal health and crop protection by 20,1%, fertilisers by 8,5% and feeds by 4,6%.

The domestic terms of trade increased by 13,9%, owing to increased producer prices, which increased on average by 6,1%, as opposed to a decrease of 7,0% in production costs.



Farming income and cash flow

The gross farming income increased by 1,1%, while the expenditure on intermediate production inputs remained unchanged, resulting in net farming income increasing slightly by 0,8%. Interest payments increased by 11,7%, while labour costs and rent payment increased by 5,2% each.

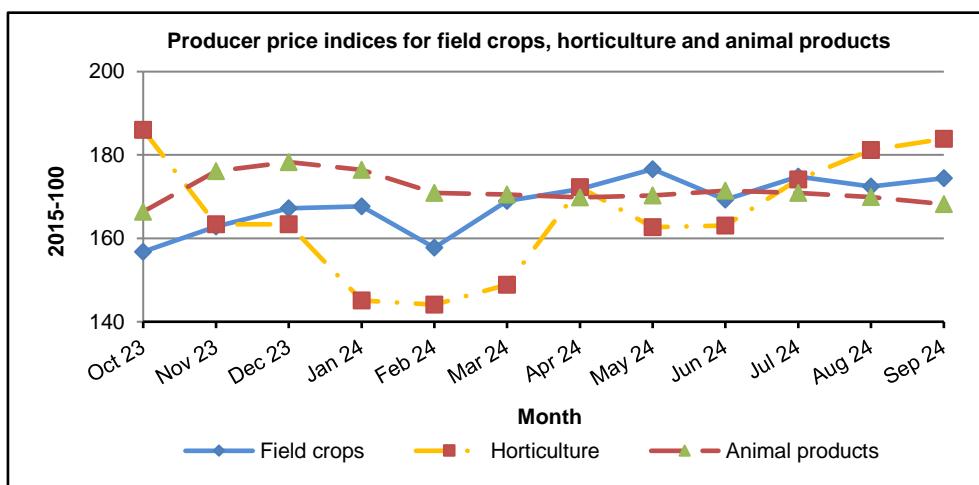
The farmers' cash flow decreased slightly by 0,1% and is estimated at R114 151 million for the period ended September 2024, as opposed to R114 236 million the previous corresponding period.

Conclusion

The increase in gross farming income was mainly driven by the increase in income from horticultural and animal products by 7,8% and 5,4%, respectively. This was influenced largely by the increase in production volumes of horticultural products, as well as the prices of some agricultural products, in particular poultry meat, sugar cane, viticulture, fruit, milk, and summer grains.

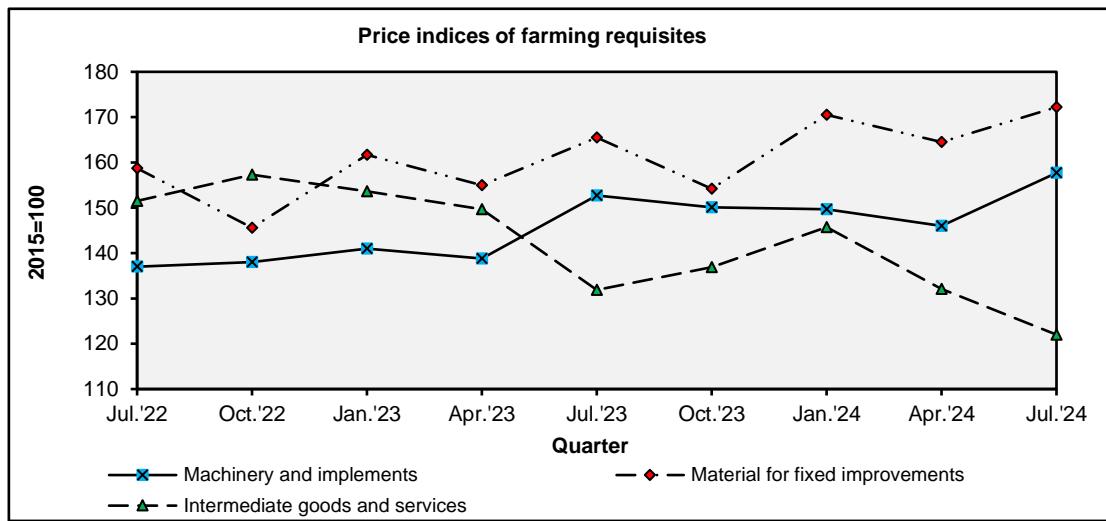

FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS OVERVIEW

FRESH MARKET STATISTICS OF SEASONAL FLUCTUATIONS IN QUANTITIES AND PRICES OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES SOLD ON THE MAJOR FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS

The purpose of this overview is to show the short-term price and volume trends (seasonal fluctuations) of various types of fruit and vegetables sold on major fresh produce markets and to make comparisons between the markets.

Market prices are determined by the interaction between supply and demand, which is influenced by various factors. Supply factors include climate, seasonal production, perishability of products and producers' reaction to prices realised in preceding periods, etc. Demand factors include consumer preferences, substitution between products and per capita income. Therefore, the seasonal pattern of quantities sold, and prices realised, may differ considerably among the various markets.
