

DO YOU HAVE PETS AT HOME? (Protect your pets)



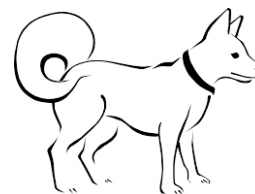

If you are tested positive, avoid kissing or licking; you may infect them
