Successful applicants will be appointed as interns for 24 months and will undergo on-the-job development training in technical, professional, business and life skills relevant and crucial for them to enter the formal job market or start their own enterprises.

Candidates must be entering the internship programme in Government for the first time. Private studying during this 24 months graduate placement programme will not be allowed.
