- An EME or QSE.

Tenderers are required to submit proof of B-BBEE Status Level of contributor.

Proof includes valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates (Verification Agencies accredited by SANAS) or Sworn Affidavit signed by the deponent and attested by the Commissioner of Oaths or B-BBEE certificate issued by the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission to substantiate their BBEE rating claims together with their tenders.

A consortium or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate for every separate tender.

NB: The department reserves the right to request bidders to submit their current Audited Financial Statement/s.

Note: Any tender not complying with the above-mentioned stipulations, will be regarded as non-responsive and will therefore not be considered for further evaluation.

Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act no. 5 of 2000 and Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2017. The 80/20 Preference Point system will be applied where a maximum of Eighty (80) tender adjudication points will be awarded for price and Twenty (20) points will be awarded for preference.
